OBJECTIVE

The Scholarship Grants for AEA members is designed to encourage employees to enroll in coursework directly related to their current position or required for other APS positions.

CRITERIA

1. An applicant must have been a member of the Arlington Education Association for **at least 90 days**.
2. An applicant's proposed course must be intended to improve the effectiveness of his/her contribution to Arlington Public Schools.
3. The application must be pre-approved by the AEA Scholarship Committee or Executive Board.
4. The amount of tuition assistance given is determined by available funds and scholarship caps. **The maximum scholarship grant is up to \$600.00 per year per applicant.** AEA Scholarship Grants are awarded based on funding availability.
5. Textbook costs are not eligible for reimbursement.

PROCEDURE

1. Obtain a catalog from the college or university and register for the desired course.
2. Complete the Scholarship Grant Application on the reverse of this form and return to the AEA Office with verification of course enrollment. **Submit a copy of the receipt indicating the amount of tuition paid and proof of enrollment / registration at time of application.**
3. After completing the course, applicants must submit a transcript showing **a grade C or better for undergraduate work, B or better for graduate work.** Scholarships will not be awarded without proof of successful completion of coursework, as listed above.
4. Scholarship awards will be given at the next Delegate Assembly meeting. Generally in September, January and May following the close of the semester. All Recipients are encouraged to attend.
